ENVIRONMENT & TECHNOLOGY

WHEN CHOOSING A SPACE TO RECORD, CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING

- ◆ Choosing a space with a stable internet connection and checking internet speed
- ◆ Select a private, quiet, and well lit space that is free of distraction (e.g. your room or car)
- ◆ Choosing a computer or tablet with a good webcam and microphone is preferred
- ◆ Using and practicing on the same device available and checking the webcam and microphone ahead of time and the day of
- ◆ Disable all notifications and calls while recording/during the interview

PRESENTATION

- ◆ Dress professionally, as you would for an in-person interview
- ◆ Practice with what you plan to wear so you can see how it looks via camera
- ◆ Position the camera at eye level so it looks like you are looking directly at the interviewer
- ◆ Make eye contact with the camera instead of the screen
- ◆ You want the interview to focus on you and your answers vs what you are wearing or the background etc.

PRACTICE ANSWERING THE QUESTIONS

- ◆ Review your personal statement and other application materials and brainstorm past experiences you have had that could demonstrate a wide variety of core competencies
- ◆ Try and provide a specific example and use clinical and non-clinical experiences
- ◆ Provide complete responses and make sure you are answering the question
- ◆ We recommend restating the question, to be as clear and concise as possible so the listener can follow along easily, and remember to keep patient identifiers private
